

Welcome Kits are given to all newly arrived refugee families. These kits are filled with useful items for those who are beginning a new life in a new place. By providing these essential items to families, you are not only helping to create a warm welcome but you are making a difference in their lives as they begin their journey of resettlement.

Additionally, these donated items help save families money. When LFSRM doesn't get these items donated we have to purchase them using funds that we would otherwise use for that family's deposit, rent, and utilities.

The following is a list of items that must be included in the Welcome Kit. You can spend as little or as much as you want on Welcome Kits but the kits must contain all of the items on this list. Please use a 15-20 quart plastic storage container for each kit. These items should be new/ unopened and full-sized not travel or hotel sized. Please do not include any food items.
